How the 2026 format works

- No timer and no outs. Each batter gets 20 swings in Round 1, 15 in the semifinals, and 15 in the final.
- Every swing counts, homer or not. Homer on your last swing of a round and you keep swinging until you miss.
- Round 1 is one 8-batter pool; the top four home-run totals advance and are seeded 1-4 for the semifinal bracket.
- Semifinals pair Seed 1 vs Seed 4 and Seed 2 vs Seed 3. Later ties are broken by three-swing swing-offs.
- Prizes: winner \$1,000,000, runner-up \$500,000, longest homer \$100,000, other participants \$150,000 each.
