Sept 23 and Sept 26 are rest days. Winners of each event earn the rainbow jersey and wear it for the year. Elite road races (in red) are the marquee events.

Good to Know

- The **99th UCI Road World Championships** bring ~1,000 riders from ~75 countries to **Montreal**, the first Worlds in Canada since 1974.
- **13 world titles** are decided across Individual Time Trials, Road Races and the Mixed Team Time Trial Relay, spanning Elite, Under-23 and Junior categories.
- Each winner earns the famous **rainbow jersey**, worn in that discipline for the following season.
- A **North American host** means US-friendly viewing times, with the elite time trials opening Sep 20 and the elite road races closing the week on Sep 27.
- Admission to all events is **free** to spectators in Montreal.
